### Description:

1. Commemoration of National Garbage Day, UNIMUDA Sorong Accounting Students participated. Garbage cleaning activities on Jalan Wisata Sorong Regency. Klasmek Village, where the majority of the people are farmers, is the potential of the village to develop and utilize manure for organic fertilizer. This organic fertilizer is produced by the decomposition of organic materials by microorganisms so that it can be used as an alternative resource that is environmentally friendly. The use of organic fertilizers is cheaper than using chemical fertilizers which are prone to danger.
